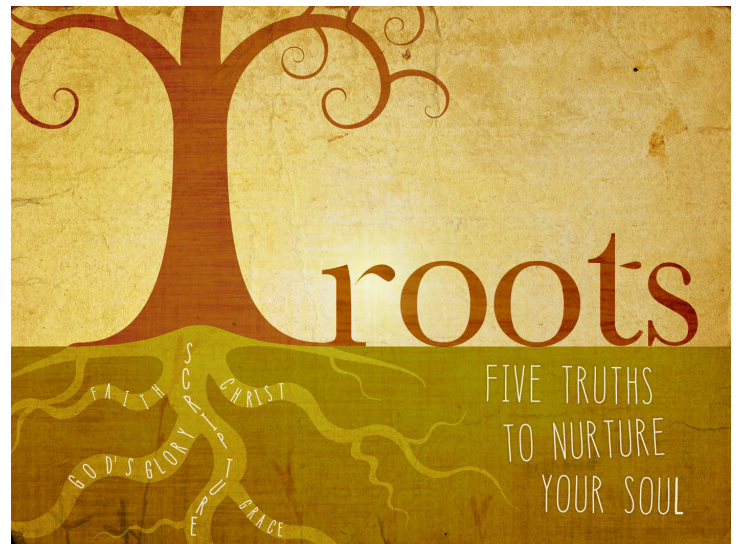

Sermon Title: Roots: "Christ Alone"

Scripture: Galatians 1:1-9

Thoughts for Worship: "Christ alone" means there is *nothing* that can be *added* to the perfect life and sacrificial death of Jesus Christ to make us acceptable to God. There is *no one* else who earns merit or serves as a mediator who can benefit our standing before God (see Acts 4:12, 1 Timothy 2:5 and John 14:6). The churches in Galatia began wavering from "Christ alone" by thinking salvation was Christ plus the works of the law. Paul denounces this in the most severe language ever uttered.

Life Application: Since we are so works-oriented by nature, we can easily attempt to add our good efforts to the death of Christ as the reason God accepts us. Paul calls this a "different gospel". How would you articulate the true gospel? Do you truly believe it?
